- Cast alloy following casting protocol, utilizing the casting machine
- Cut off sprues after casting and place in metal return containers
- Duplicate dies using duplicating materials
- Liner and opaque copings- Apply appropriate layers and material to copings evenly
- Apply wax tops- Adjust tops to fit and seal margins
- Devest rings- Use sandblaster to efficiently remove crowns from the investment.
- Contour crowns- Learn anatomy and contour of teeth to contour crowns with efficiency and ease.
- Finishing
- Smooth out surfaces of the milled product(s) for an aesthetically pleasing look using specified small hand tools, • Make necessary adjustments using specified tools (microscope, grinding tool, etc.)
